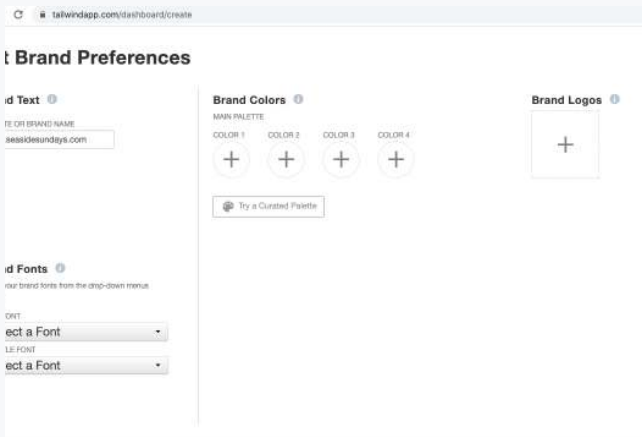


Using Tailwind Create

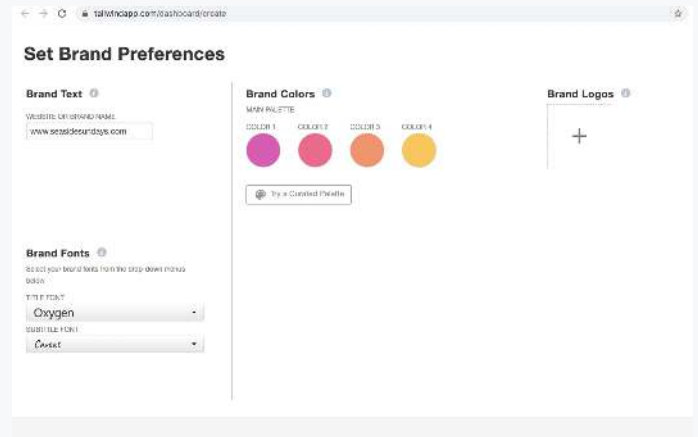
How to create beautiful pins in minutes



Getting Started

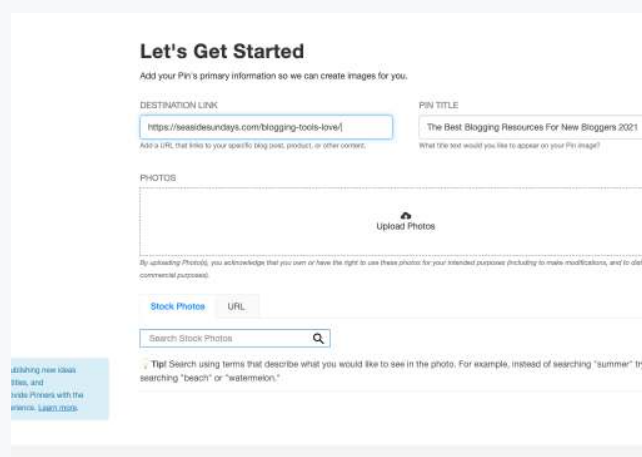
Your blog URL will be autofilled. Choose your brand fonts and upload your logo if you use one.

You can upload custom fonts too!



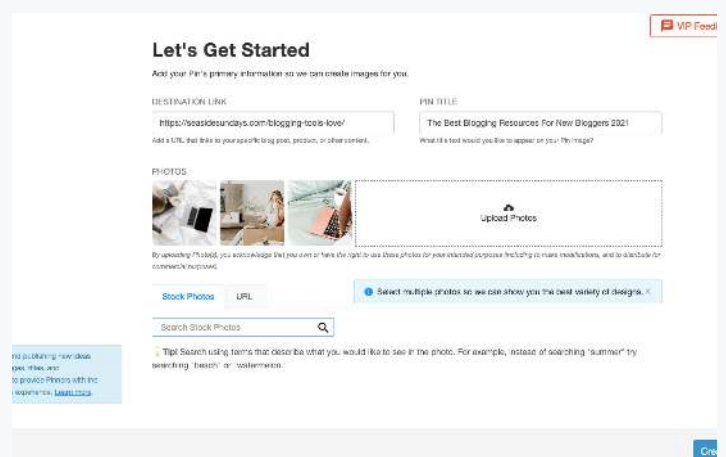
Personalize Your Pins

Next choose your brand colors (you can always change the colors on your pins later)



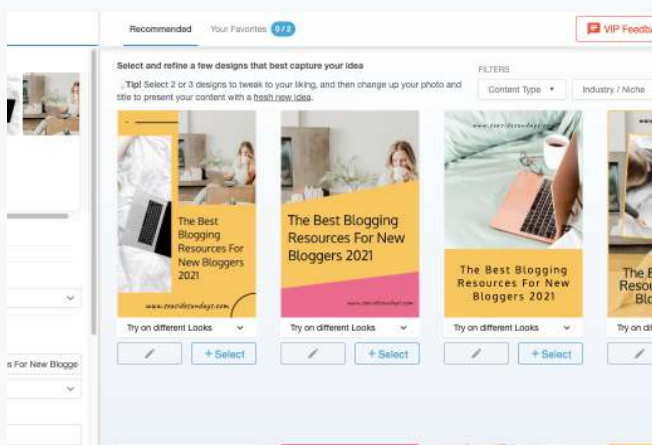
Enter Your Post URL

The title will autopopulate. This will be your pin title so change if it you want something else (you will also be able to switch it up later).



Choose Your Images

You can use the free stock photos included with Tailwind Create or upload your own photos. You can also choose for the program to pull your images from the blog post itself.



Click "Create Images"

Your pins will magically appear on the screen! Scroll down to see all the different variations.

Select a pin to download, schedule or edit the colors, font or wording. Add subtitles and more!

You are done! I recommend choosing 2-3 pins for each blog post and scheduling them out a month or so apart. That way you have consistent fresh content going out to your Pinterest feed. And don't forget to add them to Tailwind Tribes!
